### The Fast Break

**At a Glance:** Today, the Bighorns look to take the second half of the weekend back-to-back after defeating Idaho 107-85 last night...the win moved Reno to a league-best 8-1 mark at home...Reno currently sits atop the Western Conference...Wednesday, Reno will play host to the Iowa Energy, who currently hold the best record in the East.

**All-Time Series:** Tonight's epic battle marks the 17th all-time meeting between the Bighorns and Jake "The Snake" Plummer's Idaho Stampede...Idaho holds a 9-7 edge in the all-time series...Reno has won the first two of five meetings between the two teams this season by an average margin of victory of 16.0 ppg...Reno now has won 5 of the last 6 games between the two teams.

**Homework Assignments:** The Bighorns roster currently boasts two players on assignment from the NBA...**G Jeremy Lin** (Golden State) has played three games (one start) with Reno, averaging 15.3 ppg...Lin was signed by the Warriors as a free agent in July... is the only player in Ivy League history to record 1,450 points, 450 rebounds, 400 assists and 200 steals...**C Hassan Whiteside** (Sacramento) has appeared in 11 games for Reno (three starts), averaging 4.9 ppg, 2.9 rpg and 2.5 bpg...currently 3rd in the league in blocks per game and 1st in the league in blocks per 48 minutes (10.4)...Whiteside was drafted in the 2nd round (33rd overall) by the Kings in the 2010 NBA Draft.

**Twenty Something:** Last night's 107-85 victory was the first time this season Reno has played in a game decided by 20 or more points...13 of Reno's 15 games have been decided by between three and 11 points...Reno's largest margin of victory this season had been 15 points (105-90, vs. BAK on 11/26)...the Bighorns are now 4-0 in games decided by 10 or more points...Reno's largest margin of defeat this season is just eight points (12/15/10 at New Mexico, 115-107).

**Prince(s) of Thieves:** Last night, Reno set a season high by recording 16 steals...the Bighorns are currently second in the league in steals per game (10.5)...**G Aaron Miles** (1st in league, 2.5 spg) and **F Patrick Ewing, Jr.** (T-10th in league, 1.9 spg) are the top steals duo in the league...Miles has recorded at least one steal in every game this season, and 3+ steals in 6 of his last 7 games (3.6 spg over that stretch).

**Banging the Boards:** **F Mo Charlo** has been a menace on the glass over his last three games...has grabbed 30 rebounds in three-game stretch (10.0 rpg), including two double-digit rebound efforts...had just one 10+ rebound game in first nine games this season...the 'Horns are 7-0 this season when Charlo is in the starting lineup.

**Biggest Little Notes in the World:** Reno enters today's game at 2-2 in the second of back-to-back games against the same opponent...the Bighorns are a perfect 9-0 this season when committing fewer turnovers than their opponent...Reno now has used five different starting lineups in 15 games this season...yesterday, Reno improved to 4-0 when holding their opponent to fewer than 90 points.

**RENO, Nev.**—Coming out of intermission with the game knotted at 44, the Reno Bighorns outscored the Idaho Stampede by 22 points in the second half Saturday night, en route to 107-85 victory in the Reno Events Center.

The Bighorns (10-5) scored 32 points in the third period to take a lead that was never seriously threatened. The win pushes Reno to 8-1 on its home floor this season, the top home mark in the NBA Development League.

DJ Strawberry provided a spark off the bench for the 'Horns on Saturday, pouring in 21 points and six assists. Strawberry knocked-down 7-of-12 shots from the floor and finished 4-of-6 from beyond the arc.
