### The Fast Break

**At a Glance:** Tonight, Reno looks for its second back-to-back home sweep of Bakersfield this season (also 11/26 & 11/27)...win last night snapped a 4-game losing streak, their longest of the season...longest losing streak since a 7-game skid from 12/27/09—1/9/10...a win today puts Reno ahead of Bakersfield in the Western Conference standings (3rd place).

**All-Time Series:** Tonight's epic battle marks the 14th all-time meeting between the Bighorns and **Wesley Horne's Bakersfield Jam**...Reno holds the all-time series lead, 8-5...the 'Horns have won the last seven meetings in the Reno Events Center, including all three home games between the two clubs this season...after tonight, the two teams square off two more times this season (home-and-home on 4/1 and 4/2).

**Back-to-Back Jacks:** Tonight marks the ninth time this season that Reno has played the same opponent in consecutive games...7-2 in the first game this season, but just 3-5 in the second...Reno is 3-2 in the second of consecutive home games against the same opponent...after Wednesday's game vs. Springfield, Reno plays consecutive games against the same opponent six-straight times.

**Lucky Number 13:** Last night, **G Danny Green** became the 13th different Bighorn to start at least one game this season...also marked the 11th different lineup used this season and the 10th in the last 18 games...no lineup has played more than 6 games together...last night, **F Marcus Landry** was the only player in the starting lineup that also started on opening night...no player has started all 28 games...6 different players have started at the center position.

**Drop and Give Me Fifty:** The Bighorns shot at least 50% from the field last night for the 10th time this season last night...improved to 8-2 when making at least half of their shots...had shot below 50% in 6-straight games before last night...only two Bighorns shot below 50% last night (Green, Stoudamire)...other 8 players shot a combined 60.6% (43-71)...Reno's three "biggs" shot a combined 74.1% on 20-27 shooting (**O'Bryant, Richardson, Thomas**).

**Sharing is Caring:** Reno set a new team-season-high last night by dishing out 32 assists...6 players had at least 3 dimes...3rd time this season the 'Horns have recorded 30+ assists (2-1)...marked the 20th time in franchise history...Reno is now 16-4 all-time when recording at least 30 assists...the franchise record for assists in a game is 40, set on 3/26/09 vs. Iowa (131-109 win).

**Biggest Little Notes in the World:** The 'Horns have now been out-shot at the free-throw line in 7 of their last 8 games...Reno had 7 players score in double-figures last night for the third time this season...6-2 when at least 6 players score in double figures...Reno outrebounded Bakersfield 45-39 last night, despite not having a single player grab more than 7 boards...**G Jeremy Lin** has at least 2 steals in 8 of his last 10 games...**F Marcus Landry** has made at least two 3-pointers in 9-straight games.

**RENO, Nev.**—Seven double-figure scorers and 44 first-quarter points pushed the Reno Bighorns to a 116-103 victory over the Bakersfield Jam Friday night in the Reno Events Center.

The Bighorns (16-12) never trailed on the evening, taking an 11-point lead after the first period and a 13-point lead into intermission. Reno kept its foot on the pedal in the second half and put away the Jam (16-11) to snap a four-game losing skid.

"The most important thing was the 32 assists on 46 baskets," said Bighorns Head Coach Eric Musselman. "Great ball movement, extremely unselfish play tonight."

Patrick O'Bryant, who Reno acquired in a trade with Bakersfield earlier this season, scored 14 in the opening period on his way to 18 points on 8-of-9 shooting from the field. The former 2006 NBA lottery pick finished with three blocks, three assists and six boards.

Anthony Richardson hit a pair of three pointers and fell just a point shy of his season high with 22 on the night. Marcus Landry notched 20 points, and Jeremy Lin—playing on NBA assignment from the Golden State Warriors—added 10 points, five rebounds and five assists. Donald Sloan collected the game's lone double-double with 11 points and a career-high-tying 10 assists.

The Bighorns shot 52.9 percent (46-of-87) from the floor and 40 percent (6-of-15) from beyond the arc Friday.

"I was really impressed that we shot a high percentage from three with a low number of shots," Musselman said. "We didn't force up shots, and I thought we did a really good job on the backboards, as well."

Jeremy Wise led the way for Bakersfield with 34 points on the strength of three three-pointers and a 10-of-11 night from the charity stripe. Derrick Byars added 21 points and seven assists.
