The Fast Break

At a Glance: This evening, the Bighorns look to rebound from their worst loss of the season, a 111-76 defeat at home to the Utah Flash...Reno shot only 33.3% from the field and 15% from 3-point range, while being held under 80 points for only the 2nd time this season (both losses)...Reno ended January with a 5-8 record...it had won 4-of-5 entering Sunday...tonight's game will be the first time facing an opponent other than Idaho or Utah since 1/9 at ABQ.

All-Time Series: Tonight's titanic struggle marks the 3rd all-time meeting between the Bighorns and Perry Travillion's Austin Toros...the Bighorns have won both prior meetings between the two clubs...this will be the 1st of 2 meetings between Reno and Austin this season, with both games to be played at the Cedar Park Center in Austin...last season, Reno defeated the Toros 100-84 in Reno and 124-118 in Austin...**C Rod Benson** began his professional career with the Toros, playing 13 games to begin the 06-07 season...in 1 game against Austin last season with Reno, Benson scored 19 points and grabbed 16 rebounds.

Fresh Faces: Reno has acquired 4 new players since 1/19...**F Yaroslav Korolev** (trade with ABQ), **G Will Blalock** (trade with MNE), **F DeWitt Scott** (free agent) and **G D.J. Strawberry** (free agent) have made their Bighorns debut in the last 2 weeks...Blalock is leading the newcomers in scoring, averaging 18.0 ppg through his 1st 2 games with Reno...Blalock averaged 8.5 ppg in 25 games with Maine...the Bighorns are 2-2 since the addition of Korolev, and 1-1 since Blalock, Scott and Strawberry joined the team.

Start Me Up: Since being added to the starting lineup, **F Doug Thomas** has pulled down double-digit rebounds in 4-of-9 contests...he is averaging 9.3 rebounds per game as a starter, as opposed to 5.8 rpg as a reserve...he has 3 double-doubles as a starter, all in his last 6 games (all as a starter)...Reno is 5-4 (.556) with Thomas in the starting lineup...the Bighorns are 5-8 (.385) with Thomas coming off the bench.

I Just Can't Wait to Get on the Road Again: Tonight's contest marks Reno's 9th road game in its last 12 contests, dating back to 1/4 at the D-League Showcase in Boise...Reno is in the midst of playing 11-of-14 games on the road (1/4-2/6)...Bighorns are currently 5-6 during this stretch, with 3 more road games to go...after 5-straight road games from 2/16-2/25, 12 of Reno's final 16 games will be played at home (2/27-4/3).

Biggest Little Notes in the World: Prior to tonight's game, the Bighorns waived **F Yaroslav Korolev** due to injury...**G Dave Noel** has been reactivated to take Korolev's roster spot...tonight's game will be Reno's 3rd game this season played in the Central Time Zone (0-2, at SXF and RGV)...Reno's current roster features 5 players with NBA experience (Blalock, Farmer, Korolev, Strawberry, Trybanski)...these 5 players have played a total of 114 NBA games for 8 different teams...the Bighorns are averaging 19.3 turnovers per game, the highest total in the league.

RENO, Nev.—Despite a game-high 27-point effort for newly acquired Will Blalock, the Reno Bighorns were upended by the Utah Flash Sunday afternoon, 111-76, in the Reno Events Center.

Reno (10-14) jumped out to a quick lead, but the advantage would be short lived. The Flash (15-13) led by seven at intermission, then went on to outscore the Bighorns 57-29 in the second half to cruise to the victory and force a weekend split between the two teams.

Blalock, playing in just his second game with Reno, finished 9-of-19 from the floor and 9-of-10 from the stripe. He added five rebounds, an assist and one steal. The Bighorns had just one other player register double figures, as Desmon Farmer scored 10 points. Rod Benson led Reno's rebounding attack with 12 boards, including five on the offensive end.

Gabe Pruitt led the Flash with 22 points off the bench, helped by a 4-of-6 night beyond the arc. Bennet Davis grabbed 13 rebounds, while Dontell Jefferson and Andre Ingram each dished out seven assists for Utah. The Flash shot 50.6 percent from the floor and connected on eight three-point attempts.
