## The Fast Break

**At a Glance:** Tonight, the Bighorns look to get back to the .500 mark for the fourth time this season...last weekend, Reno split back-to-back games with Tulsa, winning on Saturday 102-87 before dropping Sunday's contest 100-95...Sunday's game marked just the 3rd time in 11 games that Reno failed to score 100 points...Reno is 1-2 when failing to reach the century mark.

**All-Time Series:** Tonight's titanic struggle marks the 9th all-time meeting between the Bighorns and Jinny Giery's Idaho Stampede...Idaho leads the all-time series 6-2...tonight's game is the 3rd of 8 meetings between the two squads this season...Idaho won both games against Reno earlier this season (11/28 & 11/30, both at IDA)...the Stampede outscored the Bighorns by a combined 41 points...**C Rod Benson** is averaging 18.5 points and 9.0 boards in 2 games vs. IDA this season.

**Ring in the New Year:** The Bighorns finished the 2009 calendar year with a 29-20 mark (.592)...Reno won 6 of its first 7 games in 2009, improving its season record from 1-11 (.083) to 7-12 (.368)...the Bighorns went 9-5 (.643) in the month of January a year ago, Reno's winningest month in franchise history...the Bighorns went 20-6 (.769) on their home floor in the calendar year.

**Grand Theft Basketball:** Through 11 games this season, **F Mo Charlo** and **C Rod Benson** have combined to become the best steals duo in the NBA D-League...the pair is averaging 5.1 steals per game this season, the highest total for a pair of teammates in the D-League (2nd, O. Greene/D. Jefferson, UTA, 4.4)...4 of Reno's 5 regular starters are ranked in the top-20 in the league in steals per game (Charlo, 2.7; Benson, 2.2; **G Russell Robinson**, 1.8; **G Desmon Farmer**, 1.6)...the Bighorns enter today's game with 120 steals on the season, 4th-most in the league.

**Back-to-Back Bighorns:** Tonight's game marks the 1st of back-to-back games between Reno and Idaho...Reno will play against the same opponent in consecutive games 18 times this season (including 4-straight vs. Utah, 1/20-1/31)...the Bighorns enter today's game 3-1 in the 1st of back-to-back games against the same opponent...their one loss came on opening night at Idaho...Reno is just 1-3 in the 2nd of back-to-back games...last season, Reno went 2-3 in the 1st of back-to-back games against the same opponent.

**Today's Moves:** Prior to tonight's game, **G Desmon Farmer** was waived due to injury...**G Dave Noel** was re-activated to take Farmer's spot on the roster...Noel was waived due to injury on 12/26...prior to being sidelined, Noel appeared in 9 ballgames...he scored a season-best 11 points in his last game before being waived...is expected to earn a start tonight, which would mark his 1st of the season and 25th of his career.

**Biggest Little Notes in the World:** Tonight's matchup features the 2 most potent offenses in the D-League this season...Idaho leads the league with 111.2 ppg, while Reno is tied for 2nd, scoring 104.5 ppg...Idaho is averaging 130.0 ppg in two meetings with Reno this season.

## reno bighorns gameday information

**RENO, Nev.**— Tulsa outscored Reno by 10 points in the fourth quarter Sunday afternoon, a margin big enough to lift the 66ers to a 100-95 come-from-behind win over the Bighorns in the Reno Events Center.

Reno (5-6) turned a seven-point halftime deficit into a five-point lead entering the fourth quarter. But in the final frame, Tulsa (7-6) leaned on a 12-point effort by guard Mustafa Shakur to upend Reno's bid at a weekend sweep.

Shakur finished with 19 points and seven assists, while Zabian Dowdell came off the bench to chip-in 25 for the 66ers. D.J. White and Bryon Mullens, both on assignment from the Oklahoma City Thunder, combined for 38 points and 17 boards for a Tulsa squad that shot 51.9 percent from the floor.

Desmon Farmer led all scorers with 34 points for Reno. Mo Charlo kicked-in nine points with seven assists and seven rebounds, while Rod Benson finished with 14 points, seven boards and five steals.
