The Fast Break

At a Glance: Tonight, the Bighorns are in search of their 5th-straight victory overall and 3rd-straight this season over the Utah Flash... Reno has topped the 100-point plateau in 3-straight games...over their last 4 games, the Bighorns have won each contest by an average of 12.8 points...Reno's victory on Wednesday improved the Bighorns to 5-2 in the 1st of back-to-back games against the same opponent...the Bighorns enter tonight's game 2-4 on the season in the 2nd of back-to-back games against the same team...tonight's game is the 2nd of 4-straight games for the Bighorns against the Flash.

All-Time Series: Tonight's titanic struggle marks the 11th all-time meeting between the Bighorns and Drew Sellers' Utah Flash...the series is tied, 5-5...Reno has taken 3-of-4 against the Flash this season...tonight's game marks the 5th of 10 scheduled matchups between the 2 teams...Reno plays Utah 10 times in the 09-10 season, more than any other opponent...the 2 teams square-off 6 times in the month of January alone...Reno is 2-4 all-time in the McKay Events Center.

Harvest Time: With a 32-point effort on Wednesday, **G Desmon Farmer** has now topped the 30-point plateau in 3 of his last 4 games... is averaging 31.0 points over that stretch...has scored 30-plus points 7 times this season...enters tonight's game holding the top-5 scoring performances in Bighorns history (41, 36, 35, 34, 33)...is ranked 4th in the NBA D-League in scoring at 25.1 ppg...has scored 2,739 points in his D-League career (2nd all-time, 1st-Will Conroy, ABQ).

For Fits and Starts: Reno's active 4-game winning streak marks its longest winning stretch of the 2009-10 season...this is the longest winning streak in franchise history since a 4-game swing in April last season (4/2-4/7)...the longest winning streak in franchise history is 6, set in January of last season (1/4-1/13)...this winning streak comes on the heels of a season-long 7-game losing streak...that slide was the 2nd-longest losing skid in franchise history, falling behind an 11-game losing streak last season (12/3-1/2)...

Road Weary: Tonight's game marks the final leg in the toughest road stretch of the season for Reno...from 1/4-1/22, Reno will have played 8 of its 9 games on the road...so far, Reno is 4-4 during this stretch, having started out 0-4 before winning 4-straight...in their 4 losses, the Bighorns have lost by an average of only 6.0 ppg, including 2 OT losses...of its 21 games between 1/4-2/25, only 5 will be played in the Reno.

Biggest Little Notes in the World: **F Yaroslav Korolev** made his Reno debut Wednesday night, scoring 2 points with 4 rebounds and a block in 20 minutes off the bench...was acquired by the Bighorns on Tuesday in a trade with Albuquerque, in exchange for F Marcus Hubbard...**G Dave Noel** has connected on at least 1 3-point field goal in 6-straight games and 8 of his last 9 contests...Noel hit 1 3-pointer in his previous 8 games...after tonight's game, the Bighorns will be idle for 7 days, their longest break of the 2009-10 season... Reno's record through 21 games (9-12) is 1 game better than its mark at this juncture last season.

OREM, Utah—A Doug Thomas double-double and another 30-plus point performance by Desmon Farmer lifted the Reno Bighorns to their fourth-straight victory Wednesday night, knocking-off the Utah Flash 101-93 in the McKay Events Center.

A back-and-forth affair that featured 23 lead changes fell in Reno's favor, as the Bighorns (9-12) outscored Utah (13-11) 54-46 in the second half. The four-game winning streak for Reno marks its longest winning stretch of the season.

Farmer led all scorers with 32 points, helped by a 12-of-13 night from the stripe. The USC product has now topped the 30-point plateau in three of the last four games and seven times overall this season.

Thomas scored 15 points and pulled down 11 boards before fouling-out, marking his second double-double in the last three games.

Wednesday's game also included the Bighorns debut for Yaroslav Korolev, who was acquired by Reno on Tuesday. Korolev scored two points and nabbed four rebounds in 20 minutes off the bench.

Orien Greene paced the Flash with 19 points. Bennet Davis came off the bench to score 16 and grab 10 boards for Utah.

On the night, Reno shot 90 percent from the free-throw line and pulled down 15 offensive rebounds.
